

London branch Sanskrit meeting

At the most recent meeting of the London branch of the Indian-Jewish Association, Dr Isabelle Onians, Editor of the Clay Sanskrit Library and one of her translator colleagues spoke about and read excerpts in English from key Sanskrit texts. Dr Onians is responsible for producing dual language editions of the major Sanskrit books including the Ramayana and the Maha.bharata.

The meeting was attended by many who had been schooled in the Sanskrit language; and most powerfully Dr Shree Satyanaryan Shastriji , a distinguished teacher of Sanskrit, delivered the vote of thanks in Sanskrit.

Two further meetings in London are planned for 2006 - a visit to the Hare Krishna Temple in Watford on Wednesday 25th October; and a meeting of Indian and Jewish Parliamentarians in the House of Commons on Monday 30th October.
